



## Create a bed of roses

Roses are everyone's favourites and they're great plants for beginners because they're so easy to care for.

## Here's how:

- 1. Choose a spot that gets sun for most of the day.
- 2. Improve the soil before planting by digging in lots of organic compost or manure. Plant rose as per planting instructions.
- 3. Water in well to settle the rose into its new home.
- 4. Protect roses from pests (like aphids) and diseases (such as black spot) by spraying regularly with **Yates Rose Gun** or **Yates Rose Shield.**
- 5. Because they have so much growing and flowering to do, roses need to be well fed. Yates Dynamic Lifter Advanced for Roses combines organic goodies with extra nutrients to make sure roses get all they need. Feed every six weeks while the roses are growing (that's when they have leaves).
- Prune roses in the depths of winter. Immediately after pruning, spray with Yates Lime Sulphur to clean up pests and disease and give the roses a pest-free start for the new season.
